








Contour Cab with short nose Fenders are 3" shorter than standard Used on B-44, 64, 65, 653




Flat Back Cab with shorter nose Fenders are 7" shorter than standard Notice the back of the fenders Used on B-46, 462, 67, 673, 57




Contour Cab with shorter nose Notice the same fenders as the cab above Used on B-66, 67, 673




Flat Back Cab with long nose
